CASE STUDIES

Digital Media Accelerator -for UNFPA Malawi:



During the height of the pandemic, I created and implemented the only multimedia UNFPA pilot program of its kind in Lilongwe that equipped young Malawians with digital storytelling tools. This initiative filled an educational gap, offering vital skills in communications and design, and empowering participants to confidently craft and share their own narratives.

Ethical Media & Best Practices -For MYPOL, GIZ Myanmar:

In Myanmar I led specialized training for police officers, focusing on the ethical management of police websites and social media, as well as the creation of digital content. This initiative aimed to foster positive collaboration between the police force and the media, enhancing transparency and community trust through responsible communication practices.



Nthambi Series & UN Design Projects - UNFPA Malawi



Together with my colleagues at UNFPA, I created 'Nthambi,' an animation series featuring local characters, who also appeared on various UNFPA promo materials. The aim was to educate youth on reproductive health and gender-based violence. My *Digital Media Accelerator* students also collaborated with me on design projects, extending their learning experience into real-world applications for UNFPA, WHO, UNDP, and others.

Leadership Training -For Australia Awards Alumni:

I led training for the Australian High Commission, centered on personal branding and strategic online communication. Participants gained essential skills to cultivate their digital presence and effectively communicate their advocacy efforts. This initiative aimed to amplify the voices of the Malawian alumni, leading to more robust leadership roles and a greater impact on gender-focused initiatives.

I'm an American/Portuguese multidisciplinary artist, international educator, and consultant based in Malawi.

I've taught at universities on four continents. I co-founded the Film and Digital Media BFA at The American University of Rome, where I was tenured and led the Film and Digital Media Program between 2013-2016.



From 2016 to 2019, I expanded my teaching to academic institutions and NGOs in Myanmar, including at the groundbreaking American University of Myanmar.

When not making fine art, I work as a designer and educator for United Nations agencies and international bodies, including the World Health Organization (WHO), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), The British High Commission, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World Food Programme (WFP), Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), The Public Relations Society of Malawi, United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), and The Australian High Commission.

I craft training programs catering to diverse audiences, and since 2014, I have also reached over 100,000 online students from 191 countries. My learners range from refugees and diplomats to individuals without formal education living on less than \$2 USD a day, reflecting my commitment to inclusivity and empowerment.
