Mawu and Lisa, twin deities from Benin, Africa, embody Gemini's dual nature — two forces, one wholeness. They move across Maori wave patterns from Oceania, always in motion, never still. A yin-yang symbol from Asia reflects the Gemini art of holding opposites without needing to resolve them. An Aztec sun from South America sparks the intellectual fire Gemini runs on. European lavender and North American sage bring calm to the chatter, grounding the mind that never quite stops.

Suggested Placement: A home office, creative studio, or any space where you think, write, and make things. Equally at home in a bedroom for the Gemini who processes the whole day before sleeping.
