

Sri Yantra: Miracle Meditation

This artwork is designed to support **meditation, manifestation, and the creation of intentional space.**

The Sri Yantra is built from nine interlocking triangles forming 43 smaller ones: four pointing upward for Shiva, five pointing downward for Shakti, the entire cosmos held in perfect balance between them. The central bindu, a single dot at the heart of the composition, represents pure consciousness and the origin point of all creation.

This symbol has been used for thousands of years in Hindu and Tantric devotional practice for meditation, spiritual growth, and manifesting abundance.

Suggested Placement:

Place this piece in your meditation room, on or near your altar, in a yoga or healing space, or on a North or North-East wall in your home or office to align with Vastu principles for prosperity and harmony.
